Butterfly: Leopard Lacewing (Cethosia cyane)

The Cethosia cyane was first sighted and recorded in Singapore in 2005. This attractively-patterned butterfly is common throughout the island. It breeds on the host plant Passiflora foetida, a weed commonly found in our wastelands.

You can see this and other butterflies at the Butterfly Garden at HortPark. The Butterfly Garden is open to members of the public every last Saturday of the month.
