

How to Get to Plant Science and Health Branch



The Plant Science and Health branch is located in the Animal & Plant Health Centre at No. 6 Perahu Road.

By MRT and Bus

From Choa Chu Kang MRT station, take bus 975. Alight at bus stop 33041 (Opp Lim Chu Kang Lane 3).

By Car

From PIE, exit at Jalan Bahar. Turn right and travel along Jalan Bahar which continues on to Lim Chu Kang Road in the direction of Nanyang Technological University (NTU) and the Civil Defence Academy.

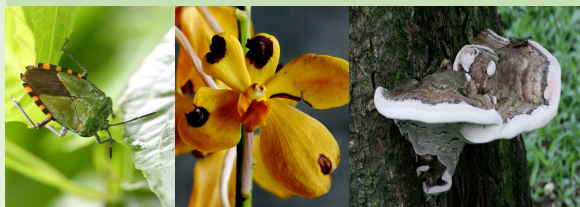

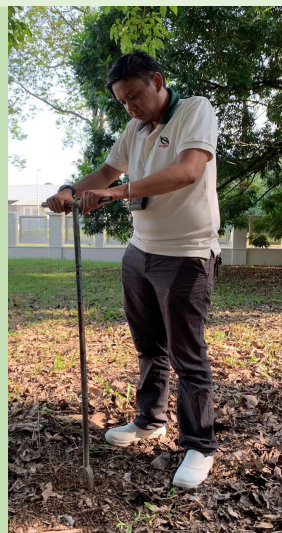


What does Plant Science and Health (PSH) do?

- Diagnose and identify insect pests, nematodes, fungi, bacteria, phytoplasma and plant viruses



- Provide consultation on soil fertility, chemical and physical soil properties for plant growth
- Conduct on-site assessment and diagnosis of plant health problems



- Conduct diagnostic tests on plants for export for phytosanitary certification and post entry surveillance samples
- Evaluate the efficacy of phytochemicals and pesticides in the laboratory and field



- Analyse nutrients in soil/planting media, fertiliser, plant tissues, compost and water



- Advise and provide training on pest management and pesticide applications



- Publish information on plant pests and diseases, pesticides, and fertilisers



Who may submit samples for diagnostic testing and analysis?

- Home garden enthusiasts
- Golf course managers
- Garden societies and clubs
- Property management corporations
- Vegetable, orchid and ornamental plant farms
- Agri-chemical companies
- Landscape maintenance companies and contractors
- Exporters and importers of plants and plant products
- Government agencies, e.g. Singapore Food Agency, National Environment Agency and PUB

How to submit samples?

You may submit samples from local and overseas locations (including Malaysia) to the PSH branch. Please note that fees for the diagnostic services apply.
