(Terminalia catappa)
Family:

Combretaceae


Recognised by their pagoda shape,

Sea Almond trees grow by coasts

and can reach up to 10½ storeys

high!

Sea Almond leaves turn yellow, orange and then red as they are about to fall, making it almost feel like autumn in Singapore.



DID YOU KNOW:

Sea Almonds have almond-shaped fruits! The edible seed kernels taste like almonds, which explains their name.
