1. Name: Asian Glossy Starling (*Aplonis panayensis*)
Colours: Glossy green, but appears black in poor light



2. Name: Javan Myna (*Acridotheres javanicus*)
Colours: Adults have a uniformly black plumage, while juveniles have a lighter slate-grey plumage



3. Name: Common Myna (*Acridotheres tristis*)
Colours: Yellow eye patch and brown body

Colours: Brown cap with generally brown plumage, and black cheeks and chin

5. Name: House Crow (*Corvus splendens*)


Colours: Black body with a grey collar
