**REVISION OF IMPORT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE IMPORT OF LABORATORY ANIMALS  
- PRIMATES INTO SINGAPORE WITH EFFECT FROM 2 FEBRUARY 2022**

The Veterinary Conditions for the Importation of Laboratory Animals - Primates will be revised with effect from 2 February 2022 following a risk assessment to ensure the safe import of non-human primates.

2 Please refer to Annex A for details of the new added import conditions, and the attachment for the revised Veterinary Conditions for the Importation of Laboratory Animals - Primates with effect 2 February 2022.

3 Importers should ensure that import of laboratory specimens of NHPs comply with this revised veterinary condition from 2 February 2022 onwards.
